Enclosed is the Expenses & Appropriations Report of the Mississippi Legislature. Section 113 of the Mississippi Constitution states, ***"The auditor shall, within sixty days after the adjournment of the legislature, prepare and publish a full statement of all money expended at such sessions, specifying the items and amount of each item, and to whom, and for what paid; and he shall also publish the amounts of all appropriations."***

The following compliance report is prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration in accordance with Sections 7-7-45, Mississippi Code Annotated (1972) and released by the State Auditor. The State Auditor received this information on October 12, 2023. Any specific questions regarding the report would best be directed to the Department of Finance and Administration.

During the 2023 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature, the Fiscal Year 2024 appropriations made by the Legislature were \$6,663,038,000 from the General Fund, \$20,577,544,142 from various special funds and an additional \$130,059,239 for funds managed outside the State Treasury. During the Regular Session, the Legislature reappropriated \$2,020,000 from the General Fund and \$2,091,156,226 from various special funds for Fiscal Year 2023. The Legislature also made additional appropriations of \$57,161,686 from the General Fund and \$729,902,498 from various special funds for Fiscal Year 2023.

This report reflects Legislative expenses of \$1,317,175.90 for the period beginning May 1, 2022, through April 30, 2023.

I am grateful to the staff of the Department of Finance and Administration for their help in preparing this report.
